INTERMEDIATE / ADVANCED INTERMEDIATE. A QuickTime video tutorial focused on a harmonica adaptation of R. L. Burnside's hill country standard, "Goin' Down South," done in the droning North Mississippi style. Technical challenges are modest, since there's nothing too fast or fancy here and there are NO CHORD CHANGES. Players will need good, accurate bends on the 2 draw (whole step) and 3 draw (half-step or "blue third") to give the song a deep blues feel. ADVANCED BEGINNERS who have some ability to bend the 2 and 3 draw will be able to get most of the juice out of this song. Harp key: A. Note: a PDF tab of this song is also available for \$2.
