Most of the selections are found in your hymnal: Great Is Thy Faithfulness, Nearer My God to Thee, Rock of Ages, And Day By Day, and many more. In addition, they include the prayerful Bach "Arioso", "Meditation", an original composition by Kathryn Cater, as well as the traditional Irish Hymn "Avondale" and "Morning has Broken". RoseWynde has released four CDs under the Sunridge Studio label since they began performing together throughout the beautiful Willamette Valley in Oregon in 1998. Their new CD Morning By Morning: Hymns and Songs for Inspiration was just released in November 2004 and includes both Celtic and American hymns and songs. This is music for spiritual uplifting and joyful meditation. Many of the arrangements include violin and cello in addition to the duo. More of RoseWynde's music can be heard on their Christmas recording, Winter Ayres, released November 2003, Distant Ayres, released summer 2002, and Walking Tune, released fall of 2000.
