This is a very dangerous and precarious position to be in, for it is the music of the Negro Spiritual that carries within its lyrics and folk melodies the strong, yet tragic, history of a beautiful and chosen people. It is this very reason that recordings such as this exist. The trio on this recording is outstanding. Pianist William Menefield is superb! His swing, touch and sensitivity has reached a level of maturity well beyond his years. Dean Hulett is the bass! His approach to the bass is as modern as it gets while still holding close to tradition
