During her career, Ms. Patzakis was managed by Columbia Artists Management (CAMI), the largest classical management firm in the world. She made her operatic debut with New York City Opera in 1993 and since that auspicious beginning, she has performed many times on both sides of the Atlantic. This singer has been a house favorite at The Theatre de la Monnaie in Brussels and has appeared at both Spoleto Festivals (in the U.S. and in Italy). She has sung in Austria, Spain, Italy, Switzerland and Canada and has performed in the United States in New York, Michigan, Texas, California, Vermont, Oregon, Arizona, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Nevada, Virginia and on regional tours with New York City Opera. Singing re-engagements, a sure sign of success, has often been the history of this complete singer/actress. As a result of her magnetic stage presence, she has

often been engaged to sing operettas, which call for the highest level of communication with the audience.
