Sean Carney performed at The New Orleans Jazz Heritage Festival with legendary pianist Big Joe Duskin and drummer/producer/journalist Ben Sandmel in May of 2002. Sean Carney has served as guitarist and musical director for legendary blues artists Christine Kittrell, Jimmy T-99 Nelson, Joe Weaver, Johnnie Bassett, Michelle Wilson, Wendy DeWitt and Bo Diddley, Jr. Sean Carney serves as Musical Director of The Island Arts Foundation in Ft. Myers Beach, Florida and organizes, promotes and performs at blues, jazz and R&B concerts there throughout the year, including The Fatback Blues Festival. During Black History Month in 2006, Sean Carney brought Willie Pooch and King Saxe Gene Walker to The Beach Elementary School for an educational presentation. Sean Carney served three terms as President of The Columbus Blues Alliance in Ohio, organizing and promoting concerts featuring pioneering artists such as Charles Brown, Jimmy Witherspoon, Earl Gaines and Hank Marr.
