I started to play around town at open mic nights, etc, and really found myself enjoying it. My sophomore year, I became friends with an SRT (sound recording technology) student at Texas State, and we decided to record some of my songs. One thing led to another, and after a lot of learning, trial, and error, I had compiled 7 of what I felt were my best songs. Seriously, the very next day, I was out trying to get people to listen to my CD. I registered jonathanclay and got to work. I'm now doing music full time, and I'm loving every second of it.
