All in all, it was truly a blessed experience." When asked who inspired her, Sadanya said, "Aretha Franklin has contributed so much to music. She is truly an inspiration and has paved the way for many vocalists who enjoy singing from their hearts and souls. When I think back, though, I would have to say that Maya Angelou, Gwendolyn Brooks, Langston Hughes, and Phyllis Wheatly taught me just how beautiful and important words can be." Sadanya's musical make-up is comprised of many elements. For example, she has had some musical training in violin, clarinet, drums, opera, and gospel. She has also attended a secondary school where she has studied voice. Sadanya's style of singing has been aided in its development by jazz songs her parents played when she was a youngster, as well as gospel music, which helped her both spiritually and musically. Sadanya's style of writing, however, seems to be one that is all her own. She often writes in prose. This gives the contemporary subjects she writes about the value of a priceless antique you discover accidentally in a thrift shop.
