A cousin, Daniel "Red" Pipkin, was an Arizona outlaw, serving seven years in the Yuma Territorial Prison for train robbery 1900-1907. Wish we knew where he hid the money! Jim Pipkin is a member of the Arizona Historical Society, the Americana Music Association, and a Roster Artist for the Arizona Commission on the Arts.
