Cherokee Sunday Morning will be released on the same day as their new DVD, Live From Washington D.C.- First Americans Festival. States choir director, Mary Kay Henderson, "This past year has been a very busy time for the choir. Kathy Sierra, the assistant choir director, and I receive 2 or 3 requests per week for the choir to perform, and while we would love to accept all requests, it's not possible, because the students are in school. But, we can't rest on our laurels too long, as we will soon be selecting new material for their next album, and holding auditions for future choir members, in January 2006." The Cherokee National Youth Choir has received multiple Native American Music Awards (NAMMY's), and is considered by many to be the preeminent native language youth choir in America. They have performed at the White House for President George W. Bush, at the Smithsonian's National Museum of the American Indian on the National Mall, and at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C..

They have also appeared in concert and recorded with legendary entertainers Dolly Parton and Rita Coolidge. Principal Chief Chadwick "Corntassel" Smith proudly states: "The Cherokee National Youth Choir is helping the Cherokee Nation achieve its goal to strengthen and carry on our rich culture through our language."
