His composition Acceptable To You has also been recorded by the Ben Hill United Methodist Church (Atlanta, GA) and the Trinity United Church of Christ Choir (Chicago). Elis latest solo release In My Quiet Time, breaks from the perennial praise and worship genre and offers his listeners the challenge to intentionally carve out time in their daily schedules to pull away and be with God Eli worked as vocal coach and childrens choir director on the movie The Apostle starring academy award nominee Robert Duvall. During the movie the children perform a Bible Rap-Song on which he was co-writer. Minister Wilson is the music director and worship leader for the Childrens Defense Funds annual Proctor Institute at Haley Farm in Clinton, Tennessee. Eli has penned more then 250 compositions for solo voice, SATB choir, childrens choir, and male voices. Eli is a native of New Orleans, Louisiana where he did his undergraduate work at Dillard University in Vocal Music Education. He has done postgraduate study at Colgate-Rochester Divinity School and the Eastman School of Music in Christian Education and Sacred Music. In 1990 he received the Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters Degree from Virginia Seminary and College. Eli is married to the former Brenda Marie Simmons.
