She received her Bachelor and Master Degrees from the Juilliard School in New York City, where she was a scholarship pupil of Dorothy DeLay. Dr. Lee's solo and chamber music recitals throughout the United States include performances in New York City for the Beethoven Society, the Metropolitan Museum, Carnegie Hall, Kaufman Concert Hall at the 92-Y, Lincoln Center, and the Centennial Celebration Series of the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn. As a participant of the Aspen Music Festival in Colorado, Dr. Lee performed regularly in Snowmass and at the Aspen Art Institute. Recent activity includes a CD release with pianist Fabio Parrini and recitals for Piccolo Spoleto, Pepperdine University, and Point Loma Nazarene University. The Fulbright Program brought him to Boston University, where he earned a Master

of Music Degree and an Artist Diploma, won the Anne and Aaron Richmond Competition, and received the Kahn Career Entry Award. After winning more prizes ("Ennio Porrino" International Competition, "Premio Citta' di Treviso"), Mr. Parrini gave recitals in Milan, Turin, Johannesburg, Boston, and San Diego, became a U.S. resident, and was selected for the South Carolina Arts Commission's Community Tour, Showcase, and Approved Artist Roster.
