Take in Abby Nyinzas vocals on Vicky or Burundian drummer Kidums duet with Kamau on Mama. Hear the eerie flavour of producer Rober Kamanzi on Taswira. Or Idi Achiengs back-ups on Fight No More Forever. Kamaus song writing, whether it be in Swahili or English, tells real stories about Africa from the vantage of someone who has been on the ground, understood and can bring it back home. Markus Kamau may be a rocker --- but he is an African rocker.
